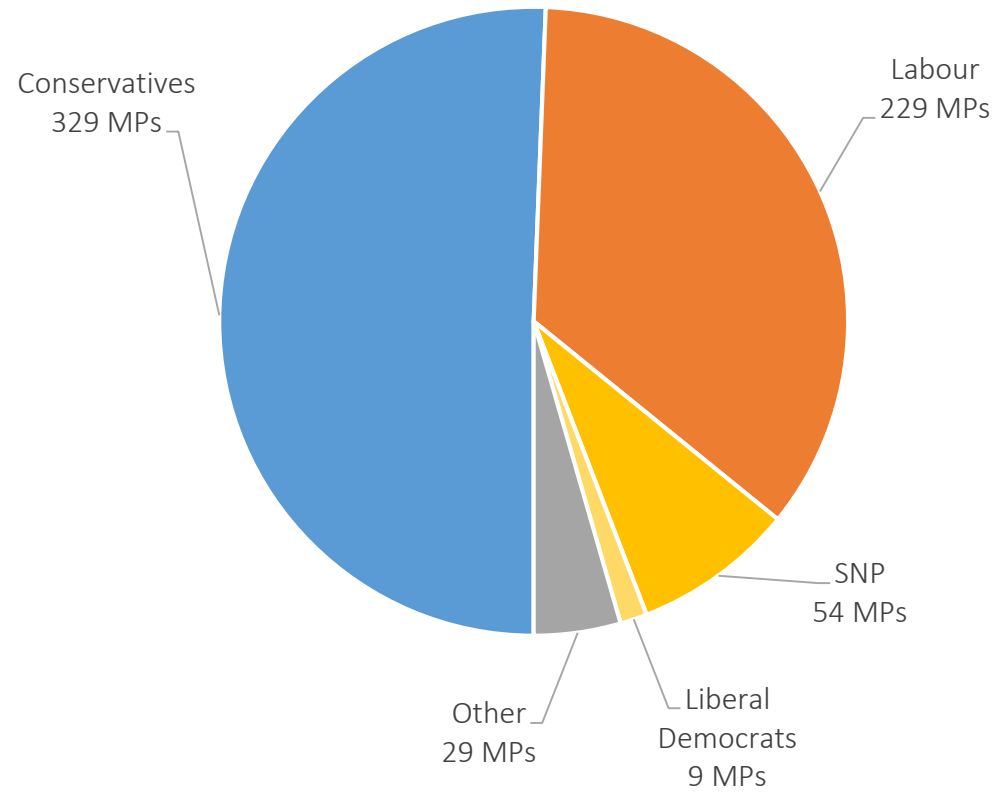

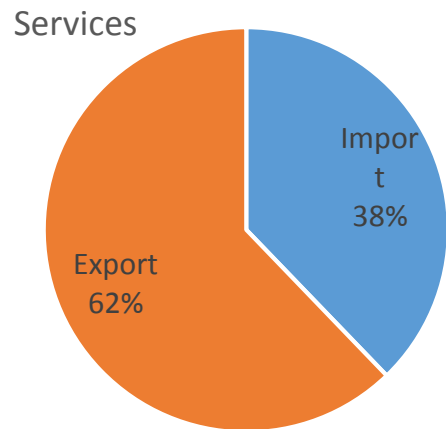
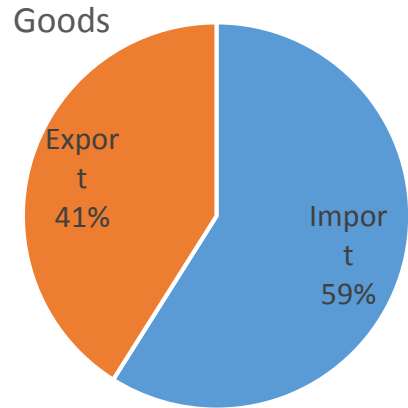


COMPOSITION OF THE HOUSE OF COMMONS

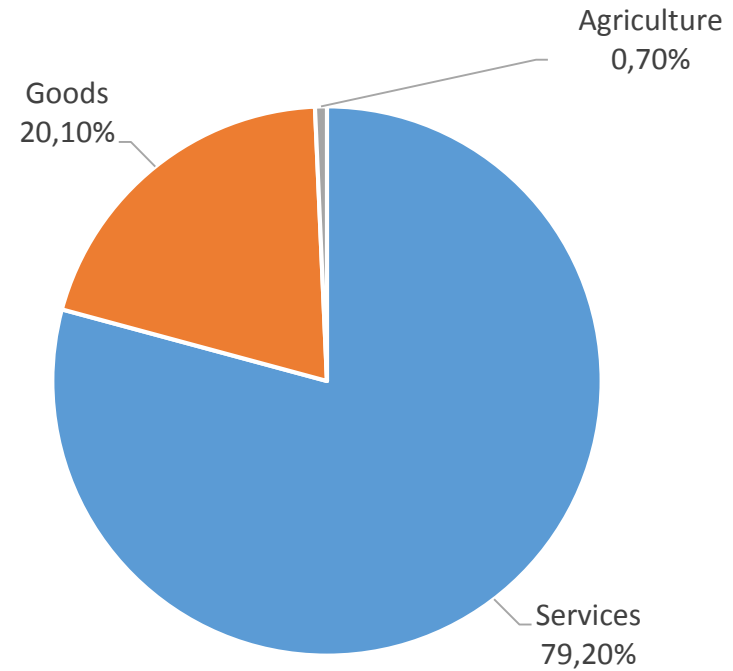


Working Government majority: 16 MPs

UK export

- 44% of UK export goes to the EU
- 54% of UK import comes from the EU

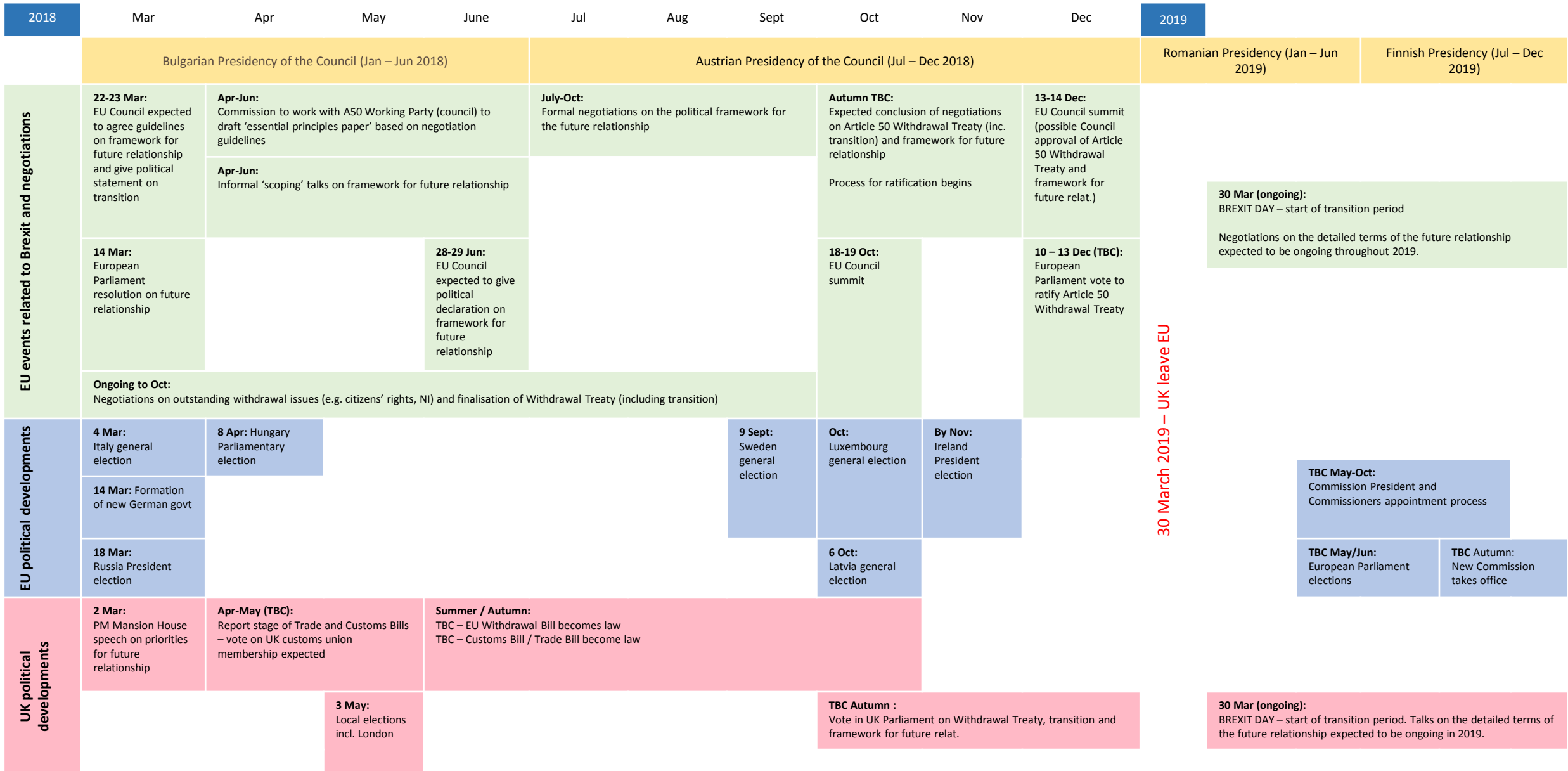
EU export

Primære risici for UK havne

- Økonomisk opbremsning – faldende mængder
 - Toldkontrol og pres infrastruktur
- Stop for fribevægelighed for arbejdskraft fra EU

- *Frictionless Border – opretholde ”Just in time”-kæder
- *Deregulering og afbureaukratisering – EU Havnetjenester
